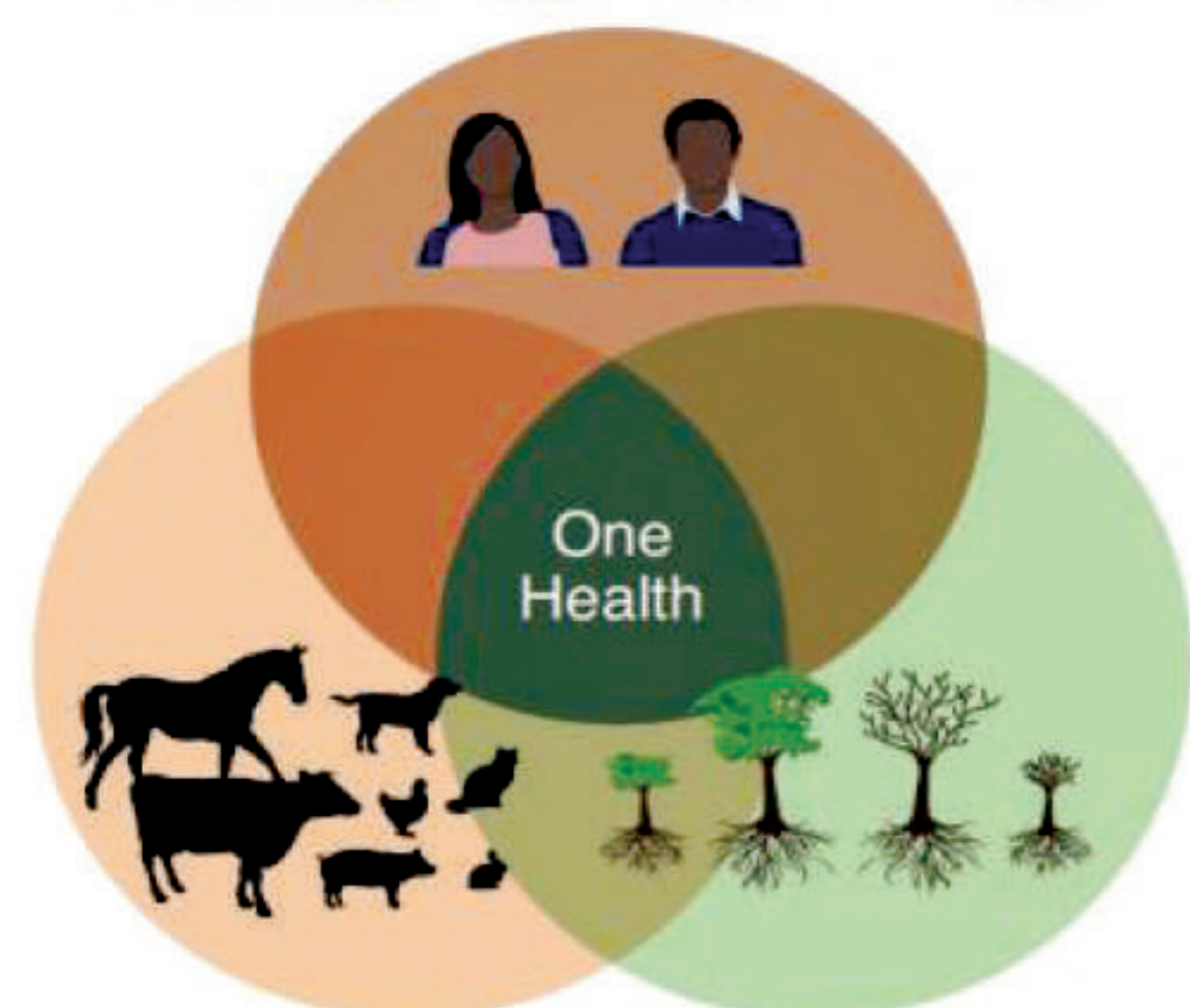

**One Health approaches in Africa**

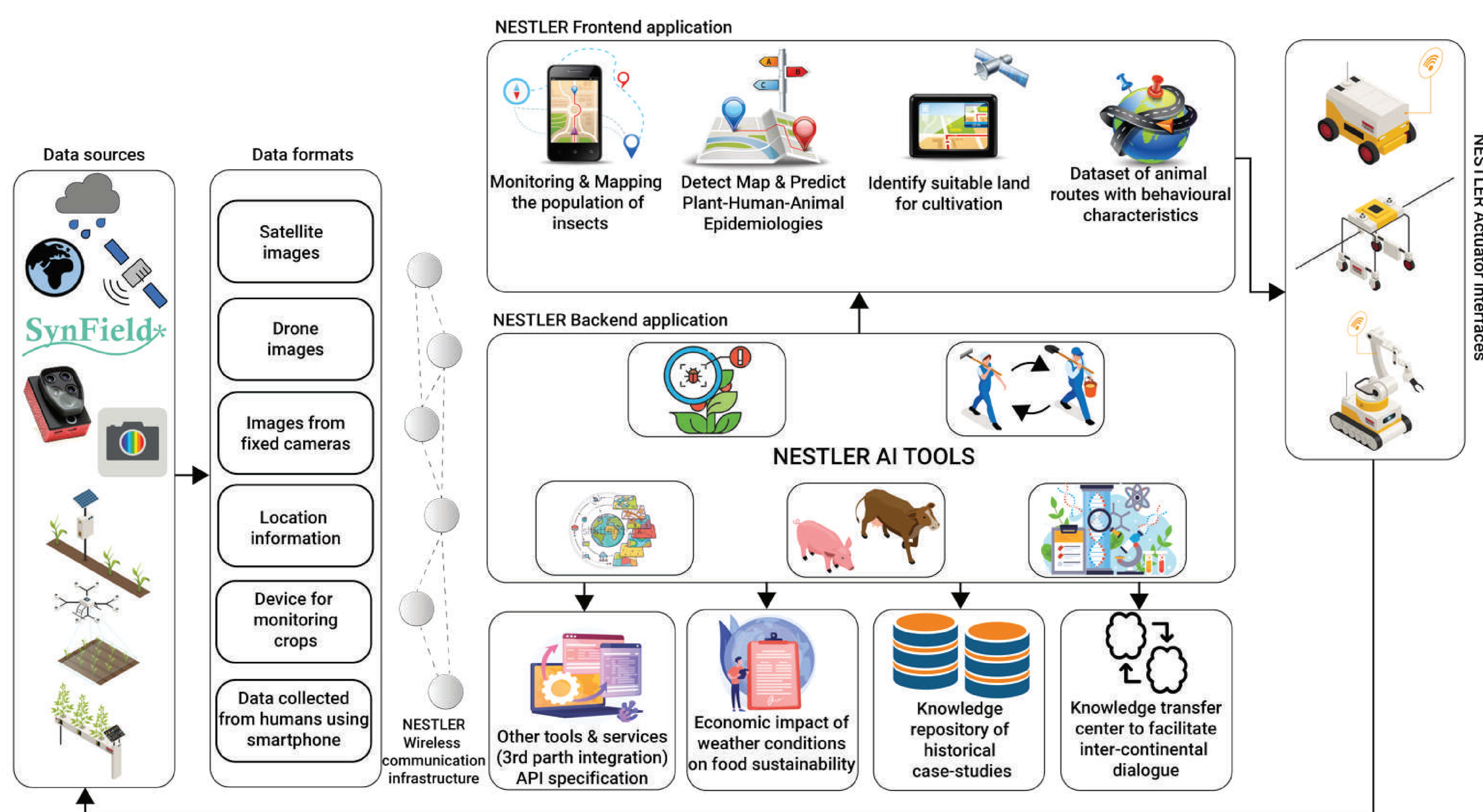


- Integrate One Health linkages into legislative frameworks to strengthen socio-ecological governance
